Implant supported prosthesis is daily needed to substitute compromised or lost teeth. Scientific literature supports the evidence that this solution is not free from biological, biomechanical and esthetic complications, especially for periodontal patients.

Clinical research demonstrated that biofilm disruption, risk factors control, appropriate hard and soft tissue reconstructions are needed to obtain short and long term clinical success in implant therapy.

This updating meeting will focus on the dental implants in patients with history of periodontal disease: what is the best prosthetic solutions, how to manage complications and how to retreat in case of failure?
