As always, the course will be in total SIdP style, with detailed arguments starting with diagnostic and prognostic considerations and then focusing on the surgical and non-surgical clinical aspects in periodontology and implantology. Each presentation will have the characteristics of a real didactic course with many images and videos.

Topics for the sessions dedicated to the Dental Hygienists will also address how to communicate a clinical complication/failure to the patient and the dental team and how to contribute during the post-surgical healing phase to the management of surgical wound failure in order to reduce the consequences of a complication on the final result.

The Coordinators, as expert clinicians on the specific topic of each session, will have the task of introducing the topic and working before and during the Course with the speakers in order to ensure the best outcome of each individual presentation, to avoid overlapping and to encourage the live participation of the audience through a discussion which can lead in the end to shared conclusions.

Our Top SIdP speakers were asked to present a clinical nightmare case, show the treatment that was done in order to solve the case and describe all the clinical considerations needed to avoid such mistakes and reduce complications in future similar clinical cases.

I sincerely thank the Coordinators and Speakers for their availability and competence and I invite you to participate in Florence, where I'll be happy to welcome each of you in person.
