Clinical Case Competition for Students and Young Clinicians.

The **CURASEPT 4 WOMEN project** is a branch of a broader corporate program called Curasept 4 with the purpose of "telling" stories of our profession that can be an inspiration for our younger colleagues.

In 2022 the project is dedicated to a few and well known women within the dental field who discuss about their own difficulties and success, thus becoming video testimonials of the perseverance and hard work needed in order to achieve their goals in a very competitive and crowded world of oral health.

In the project **CURASEPT 4 WOMEN** the company sponsors in the amount of 3000 euros, two Awards of 1500 euros each, dedicated to Dental Students/ Young Dental Graduates (maximum age 35 years old) and Hygiene Students / Dental Hygienists (maximum age 35 years old).

The awards will be presented by the Italian Society of Periodontology and Implantology (SIdP) for the best clinical or research case dedicated to periodontal pathology in women.

Possible topics of interest:

- Periodontics and pregnancy
- Gingivitis and hormonal profile
- Periodontics, menopause and osteoporosis

The candidates must present an abstract in Italian or English before the deadline.

Deadline for sending the abstract: February 5th 2023

The abstracts must be submitted to the Scientific Committee of the Italian Society of Periodontology and Implantology (**SIdP**) for evaluation.

The acceptance will be communicated to the Secretary of SIdP before **February 18th 2023**.

Guide for abstract submission

Research competition

The work presented must be a clinical research in periodontics or implant dentistry related to the oral pathology in women.

Please use the **on line form** on the **<u>www.sidp.it</u>** and subdivide the work as follows:

- Aim of research
- Materials and methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- Aim of research maximum of 500 characters included spaces
- Materials and methods max 1500 characters included spaces
- Results max 1500 characters included spaces
- Conclusion max 1000 characters included spaces

The abstract can include pictures - TIF or JPEG high resolution(minimum resolution 300 dpi, printed format 6 x 9cm) and tables (up to 7) accompanied by captions. Clinical case competition

The clinical case must present a clinical case of periodontal or peri-implant therapy in relation to pathology with higher prevalence in women.

Please use the **on line form** available on the **www.sidp.it** website and further subdivide the work as follows:

Premise, Clinical Case Presentation, Conclusions.

Premise - maximum of 500 characters included spaces
Clinical Case Presentation - maximum of 1.500 characters included spaces
Conclusions - Max. maximum of 1.000 characters included spaces
The abstract can have figures - TIF or JPEG high resolution(minimum resolution 300 dpi, printed format 6x 9cm) and tables (up to 7) accompanied by captions. The work must be

The following criteria will be used to evaluate the work presented:

- originality of the hypothesis
- research set up and design
- applied methodology
- scientific and clinical importance

After the evaluation of the SIdP scientific commission **three** cases of most value will be chosen for each category.

The selected cases will be presented for **ten minutes**, followed by **five** minutes of discussion in front of the Evaluating Committee composed of a SIDP member of the directing committee, a University Professor of Periodontics and an active SIDP member who is a practicing clinician, at the 2024 annual SIDP congress. The Commission will indicate the winner of the 1500 euro prize for the best scientific/ clinical paper in the Student in Dental Hygiene/ Young Dental Hygienist category, and the winner of the 1500 euros for best scientific/ clinical paper in the Dental Student / Young Dentist category.

The winners will be announced during the last day of the 2023 International SIDP Congress (March 9-11, Rimini). The winning papers will be presented in one of the SIdP cultural initiatives in 2023 and will be published on the SIdP website.
