Dear Colleagues,

We all know that there is an intimate and inseparable relationship between periodontal health and dental restorations. Already in 1961 Anthony Gargiulo defined the concept of biological width as an inviolable biological protection between bone crest and supra- and sub-gingival biofilm. Since then, many scientific publications have shown how the position, precision of the margins and the emergency profile of crowns and fillings can alter, sometimes irreversibly, the state of health of periodontal tissues.

So much time has passed, scientific knowledge has expanded and operational techniques have grown in number, but many clinical doubts are still, at least in part, unresolved. Sometimes we may feel confused about choosing the right solution. We know the importance of biological width, but do not yet know for sure whether the respect of both its components, epithelial and connective, is of equal importance. We do not know if their measurements are constant in all patients and in all teeth. We know the influence of the tissue biotype on the stability of the gingival margins in proximity of restorations, but we do not yet have the scientific evidence that allows us to classify the tissue biotype with certainty, nor to determine with equal confidence the margin position and the best emergency profile for that particular tooth and patient. Likewise, we know that the mechanical resistance of a dental element is directly proportional to the amount of healthy dentin present, but the scientific evidence of which type of restoration is best for ensuring the long-term success of the restored tooth is still missing

More recently, the improvement in Conservative and Prosthetic Dentistry of adhesive techniques, the possibility of "moving" the restoration margins into a more coronal position by their "relocation" with composite resin, the opportunity to treat cervical lesions with a combined conservative-periodontal therapy and, finally, new materials and the fascinating prospective of obtaining a coronal growth of the gingival tissues through specific prosthetic procedures, on the one hand have increased the therapeutic possibilities, on the other have also made it more difficult for the clinician to choose the most suitable treatment for each patient.

Aesthetics of the restorations, harmony, stability and health of the gingival margins, function, resistance of the artifact and of the residual dental structure and the possibility of hygienic maintenance are the objectives to be achieved.

In other words, we all share doubts and difficulties in making the right decisions to correctly perform our daily therapies for which we wish to be able to predict the best possible prognosis.

Dear Friends, it is for all these reasons that we have strongly desired a cultural event that, thanks to the scientific and clinical values of SIdP, AIC and AIOP, can only be of great educational level. We are sure that these three great scientific societies will develop a debate able to provide the best possible answer to our many clinical doubts on the subject.

The format envisages the simultaneous presence on the stage of all the speakers of the individual sessions led by the Coordinators. Each session will involve a lot of interaction with the formulation of specific questions even during the presentations, to end with an interactive discussion that will involve us all and, we are sure, will thrill us.

We believe it will really be a moment of education and experience that cannot be renounced.
