#### **Presentation**

Why a Course on Gingival Smile, why a course strongly oriented towards smile aesthetics? We are all well aware that periodontology plays a key role to ensure not only oral health but also and above all an overall and systemic well-being. In light of this, together with the Cultural Committee, we thought useful and necessary to look also at what can make the well-being and quality of life of our patients even more complete: **the smile**. The great conductor Daniel Barenboim said that "culture is not only aesthetics but also ethics". We want to anagram this sentence by saying that culture is not only ethics, but also aesthetics. We want to do it by addressing the issues concerning aesthetics from an ethical point of view, following a systematic and evidence-based approach, the only way to be able to share between us clinicians and between clinicians and patients a defined path and a clear therapeutic objective.

We will start from the **dento-skeletal diagnosis**, addressing what orthodontics and maxillofacial surgery can do to prevent and correct the alterations deriving from an *excessive gingival display*. We will see how much and how **the periodontal component of the gingival smile may affect the treatment** and we will have the opportunity to enjoy a **Live Surgery** to understand all the steps necessary to adequately perform a corrective surgical procedure. We will also be able to observe the **aesthetic restorative techniques** required to the improvement of the smile and with a video session we will enter into the treatment phases of an interdisciplinary case. Then on Saturday we will finally face what can be a truly nightmare as described in the title: **when periodontal disease determines its devastating effects in aesthetic areas in the presence of excessive gingival exposure**. This may need to resort to a perio-prosthetic strategy or decide when an implant alternative can be indicated or contraindicated. We will also have a **session for Dental Hygienists and Dental Hygiene Students entirely dedicated to the maintenance of periodontal tissues and the perio-restorative interface, in order to understand the approaches and tools suitable for avoiding alterations of the dento-gingival aesthetics.** 

In summary, we will face a fascinating journey in the smile of our patients. Smiles that have run parallel with the 40 years of our Society and that we want and must be prepared to face as an additional challenge to achieve that overall health of our patients, which also passes through their ability to regain their smile again.

We are waiting for you in Bologna for a Course of great charm, your smile cannot be missing!
