Dear Friends,

here we are again with the most important event of the cultural program of the year.

With great pleasure I would like to present to you the 21st International SIdP Congress titled: "Reducing invasiveness without compromising the clinical outcomes".

The words minimally invasive are increasingly being used in surgery to define an approach aimed at reducing patient discomfort, improving wound healing processes and reducing complications.

In this Congress we want to explore the concept of invasiveness in periodontology and implantology, with a wide perspective and always referring to the predictability of clinical results.

This means investigating issues related to the suitability of diagnostic approaches, especially in light of the diffusion of new 3D imaging technologies and artificial intelligence, even before discussing non-surgical and minimally invasive surgical approaches in periodontal and implant therapy in terms of indications, methods and procedures, as well as the conscious use of biomaterials and additional therapies.

We will also discuss the rational use of drugs, in particular systemic antibiotics, considering the alarm coming from the WHO whose estimates indicate that in the year 2050 10 million people might die from causes related to antibiotic resistance.

All this will be done through Italian and foreign Speakers who will deepen the topics assigned to them in the light of scientific evidence and will interpret the data in a purely clinical manner.

I hope that once again this Congress will prove to be an authentic opportunity for aggregation and as I like to say, for "contamination of ideas". A place where it is possible to meet and experience moments of scientific knowledge, professional inspiration, getting together and cultural exchange in a broad sense.

All the different membership categories will be represented, including experts and opinion leaders in various subjects, young dentists, students, general practitioners, and "pure" researchers. For the Hygienist members, a scientific program has been prepared that develops the same themes as the Dentists, with joint sessions and others specific to the category.

Going into details regarding the contents of the Congress:

Thursday we will start with an intense pre-congress day with several Workshops and Lunch & Learn sessions, as well as the prestigious Goldman, Vogel, Cagidiaco, Cevenini Awards in which researchers and clinicians, Dentists and Hygienists, will openly discuss periodontal and implant topics, according to the usual SIdP style.

I remind you of "Spazio Giovani-Young Forum" managed as always by the organizing junior committee "SIdP Giovani", in which a hands-on session on the application of minimally invasive techniques in mucogingival surgery will be organized, with a step-by-step description of the procedures and guided exercises on surgical preparations from the *SIdP Giovani* tutors.

In the afternoon of the same day, 2 pre-congress Courses will be held, specifically for Dentists and Dental hygienists with a very practical format and step by step explanation of different techniques. The one aimed at dentists will cover mini-invasiveness in periodontal and implant surgery. The Course aimed at Hygienists will deal with the same topic in non-surgical periodontal therapy.

The end of the day provides a unique opportunity for our business partners to present, during the Forum for Innovation, the most recent technological and research innovations for the benefit of our patients in a session that is always very popular, coordinated by SIdP active members.

On Friday the Congress will officially start with a common session presenting an Opening Lecture that will make us critically think on the belief that technology itself can solve any health problem and a Lectio Magistralis on the invasiveness and effectiveness of periodontal and implant therapy.

After this first joint session, we will have separate sessions for Dentists and Hygienists, always interactive, with discussions and final shared considerations on the topics mainly concerning periodontology. On Saturday the implantology topics will be discussed.

At the end of the Congress, I would like to point out the session introduced last year that had such a great success: *The post-Congress: let's learn from the Experts!* It is a session consisting of 3 courses of 3 hours and 1 course of 2 hours (reserved to International Members), in which international speakers, in an informal and relaxed way, will show the participants with images, diagrams and many videos, when, why and how to do it in guided implantology, in prevention of pathologies of the oral cavity and communication techniques in the dental office.

Finally, one more mention to the Training Camp, Hands-on of periodontal surgery reserved for Senior Dental Students former AISO members, held by a leading academic team.

I am waiting for you all at the Congress, I am waiting for you all to take part in the SIdP family!
