Dearest Friends,

with immense pleasure I present to you the 23<sup>rd</sup> SIdP National Congress, titled **Quality of Care and Prognosis in Periodontology and Implantology**, the first cultural event of my two-year Presidency.

At the same time there will be a beautiful **Congress reserved for Dental Hygienists** which, thanks to extraordinary Speakers, will constitute a journey into the complex problems of the aging patient, with the implications of systemic health, maintenance of motivation and all their periodontal and implant consequences.

The Saturday afternoon After Congress will continue to be a unique event, with a Training camp for Dentistry Student Members who were already AISO Members and four theoretical courses held by super Experts (one in English language).

I'm sure they will be three wonderful days, in which we will be able to interact with the greatest minds and ask questions and find answers, but more than anything else, nourish enthusiasm and passion for our beautiful profession. They will be, as always, three days of friendship and sincere passion.
