# Peri-implant diseases therapy: Operative procedures and maintenance of the results

## **Course Presentation**

As in any other medical or surgical procedure, the use of osseointegrated implants involves the need to acknowledge the biological foundations that regulate their clinical behavior over time. In addition to this, of great importance is to understand all those systemic and local factors that, in different types of patients receiving the same therapy, can lead to different clinical results. Only adequate knowledge, associated with a correct clinical practice, can allow therapeutic and prognostic success.

Last year we dealt with implant malposition. We discussed the problems that could be caused by an incorrect planning or therapeutic execution.

This year instead, we will deal with the issue of peri-implant diseases, which, given their high prevalence, heavily affect the clinical practice. We will start with the analysis of the etiopathogenetic factors that influence the genesis of biological complications of osseointegration and with diagnosis and prognosis of peri-implant diseases.

We will then move on to a more clinical part of the Course supported by Tutorial Video Sessions aimed at illustrating the operative procedures for treatment of the peri-implant infection in its several steps. The Course, through the innovative video tutorial, will illustrate step-by-step every single procedure and will allow us to face every clinical procedure starting from decontamination and disinfection of the implant surface. We will evaluate together how far non-surgical therapy can go and when a decontamination by means of conservative surgical therapy for treatment of peri-implantitis becomes necessary.

Saturday will be dedicated to "protective" mucogingival surgical procedures to maintain healthy implants, resective or regenerative surgeries when the bone defect induced by implant infection requires, in addition to biofilm control, an anatomical correction. The goal is to give clear and practicable information in the clinical reality.

Last Saturday session will allow us to face the peculiarities of the supportive therapy, which is fundamental in the maintenance of these situations. We will try, through some questions the coordinators will ask to the speakers as well, to understand when it might be more useful to proceed with the removal and/or replacement of the contaminated implant.

Topics of significant clinical utility.

To have specific knowledge and skills in the treatment of peri-implant diseases is essential.

Our task will be to distinguish false myths from an appropriate clinic approach.
