G. CARDAROPOLI AWARD 2021

To honour the memory of Dr **Giuseppe Cardaropoli**, SidP Active Member, who dedicated his professional life to periodontal and implant research and to the sharing of knowledge amongst younger colleagues, the **Italian Society of Periodontology and Implantology** (SidP) established the "**Giuseppe Cardaropoli Award**" for the best presentation at its **20th International Congress 2021** in the **POSTER** session called "**RESEARCH FORUM**", offering to clinicians and researchers the chance to present and discuss their own scientific studies in the field of Periodontology and Implantology.

Both clinical research and basic sciences research are eligible.

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by a specific Committee constituted by eminent academicians and clinicians and by the Coordinators of the session. The works will be presented in **POSTER FORM** and subsequently published as abstracts in English in the journal "*Quintessence International & Jomi*".

The Committee will evaluate submitted abstracts according to clinical relevance, language clarity, scientific methodology, materials and methods and their conformity of with given aims, the consistency of the conclusions with respect to the results obtained, ethic, scientific value, clinical significance and originality.

Abstract Submission

Abstract should be written in English language. Deadline for submission will be June the 22nd 2021 only and exclusively using the appropriate preformed form available on the website www.sidp.it (section Calls, Scholarships and Awards).

Only on-line submitted abstract will be accepted and considered for evaluation.

Acceptance will be communicated through e-mail from the SidP Secretariat within July the 15th 2021.

The presentation will not be accepted if the presenting Author would not be pre-registered in the Congress.

Presentation and discussion will be in English or in Italian language.

Failure to pre-register at the Congress will result in the cancellation of participation in the session. Failure to present the work in the dedicated session of the 20th International SidP Congress will not allow publication in the journal edited by Quintessence. Each Author may appear as presenter in only one abstract, but as co-author in an unlimited number of abstracts

The abstract submitted should not have been published or presented before.

During the SidP National Congress, the Evaluating Committee will award the **Giuseppe Cardaropoli Prize** for the best work presented, acknowledging to the Author who presented it the **free registration for one year to SidP**.
