
The post-Congress on Saturday afternoon will continue to be a unique container, with a Training Camp for Dental Student Members and theoretical Courses held by top Experts.

In particular, the onset of chronic diseases such as cardiovascular diseases, diabetes, and oncological conditions is common in old age and has profound implications in periodontology.

This PerioLinks event will explore the biological mechanisms of aging, the diseases associated with it, and its key connections to periodontal health.

Nicola Discepoli, together with journalist Max Sisto, will coordinate an outstanding group of speakers.

Niccolò Marchionni, Professor Emeritus of Geriatrics, will discuss aging and cardiovascular risk.
