

"HENRY M. GOLDMAN" AWARD 2025

The Italian Society of Periodontology and Implantology is pleased to inform those wishing to submit one or more papers for the 'H.M. Goldman' prize to be awarded during the <u>Annual Congress 2025</u> (Rimini I, 13-15 March), must send the text, in electronic format, **no later than February 17**th, 2025 for evaluation, for the purpose of acceptance by the Scientific Commission.

Papers submitted may cover basic research, laboratory research or clinical research (clinical trials or innovative surgical techniques) provided they pertain to the different aspects of scientific and clinical research in periodontology and implant therapy.

The paper should be sent in **English language** and should:

- be composed of a short abstract (max: 200 words) and a text divided into Introduction, Materials & Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions and Bibliography;
- not be exceeding 3.500 words and be accompanied by no more than 7 figures and tables;
- be sent in electronic format by e-mail to: segreteria@sidp.it.

The work must be original and not have been published and / or presented previously in other scientific events. Scientific works that have already been submitted and / or accepted for evaluation to any scientific journal by the expiry date of the call will not be taken into consideration by the Commission.

The above editorial lines are mandatory for the evaluation of the manuscript by the Commission.

The most interesting works will be presented in Italian or English during the 2025 Annual Congress.

The candidate will have a time of 20 minutes and 5 minutes for discussion.

The notification of acceptance or not will be sent by e-mail by February the 28th 2025.

The works that will not pass the selection for the H.M. Goldman may be selected to be presented in the "Research Forum - G. Cardaropoli Award" which will also be held as part of the SIdP 2025 Annual Congress. The access procedures and regulations for this Forum are available at the Society's website: www.sidp.it, in the section "Announcements and Awards 2025".

Among the works presented at the Congress, two will be selected, one for basic / laboratory research and one for clinical research, to which the "H.M. Goldman Prize" will be assigned, together with a financial recognition of $\in 2,000$.

At the sole discretion of the Commission, no prize will be awarded in the absence of works deemed particularly worthy.



The Commission reserves the right to assign the two available prizes to two particularly deserving works also of the same address (basic research or clinical research).
